Bavarian from a Tyke perspective

Dear members and friends,

The Anglo-Bavarian Club's resumed activities continue with a presentation by Prof. Anthony Rowley, Germanist and dialect expert on Wednesday, 15 March 2022, 18:30.

Dialects have been a topic of interest in Bavaria since the 17th century, earlier than anywhere else in Europe.

In the C.19, the Yorkshireman Joseph Wright came to Germany to study and went back to write a dictionary of English dialects.

Your speaker came from Yorkshire and ended up working in Munich on a dictionary of Bavarian dialects.

What are the similarities and differences between the situation of dialects in the U.K. and Germany, in England and Bavaria?

And what can you do with dialect research?

Anthony Rowley, born 1953 in Skipton, England. 1971 - 1975 studied German and Linguistics at the University of Reading for BA.

1975 - 1977 grant from the German Academic Exchange Programme for the University of Regensburg. 1977 M.Phil.

1978 - 1988 Wissenschaftlicher Assistent, Chair of German Language, University of Bayreuth. Married, 2 grown up kids, lives in Augsburg.

1980 Dr. phil., thesis „Fersental (Val Fèrsina bei Trient/Oberitalien): Beschreibung einer Sprachinselmundart“.

1988 Habilitation („Morphologische Systeme der nordostbayerischen Mundarten in ihrer sprachgeographischen Verflechtung“), venia legendi Deutsche Sprachwissenschaft.

1988 - 2019 editor in chief of the Bayerisches Wörterbuchs at the Bavarian Academy of Sciences, Professor at the Ludwig-Maximilian-Universität Munich. Retired since 2019.

2022 Bayerischer Verdienstorden.
